

# LANE COVE SUPERSTAR

Lane Cove Superstar is a solo-singing competition, for young people aged 12-20 years who live in or have connections to the Lane Cove area. After a process of auditioning, finalists will be notified and the event will culminate in a final performance in the Lane Cove Plaza on Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> September 2007 at 1pm.

**Auditions** – Will take place over two Fridays, 24<sup>th</sup> August and 31<sup>st</sup> August 2007 at Synergy Youth Centre, 1 Little St, Lane Cove. (under the pool grandstand) at 7pm. Each contestant will be given a 3-5 minute slot to perform one song to a panel of judges. A select number of contestants will then progress to the final performance on 15<sup>th</sup> September. There will be some great prizes on offer and the competition will be judged by people that work in the music industry.

**Performance workshop**- Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> August at Synergy Youth Centre at 1pm. The workshop will be facilitated by Jackie Love a well respected person in the music industry with the objective of giving contestants pointers in performance and also assisting them to enhance their skills. The workshop will involve audition tips such as presentation, confidence, song choice, dealing with anxiety as well as singing tips. Bookings essential for this workshop.

Lane Cove Superstar is funded by Lane Cove Council and a grant from the NSW Department of Education and Training through the TAFE NSW program titled ArtStart. The ArtStart NSW Youth Arts and Skills program (ArtStart) is an initiative of the NSW Government designed for young people in New South Wales. The program provides opportunities for young people to develop skills through participating in arts and cultural projects as well as performing and exhibiting their work during a regional showcase. A number of arts and cultural projects have been funded throughout the Northern Sydney area and a regional showcase of these projects will take place on Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> September in Chatswood. The top three finalists will be invited to perform at this showcase.

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The competition is open to young people aged 12 -20 years.
2. Registrations will be accepted until Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> August. Contestants will be notified of their audition night and time allocation after the closing date.
3. Three judges will select the contestants to progress through to the final.
4. Brief comments will be given to contestants by the judges after each performance.
5. The judges decision will be final.
6. Contestants give their permission for Lane Cove Council to use photographs and video taken during the competition for advertising, editorial and press releases relating to Lane Cove Superstar.
7. Each contestant is to sing one song of their choice only. If successful in progressing to the final, contestants will need to have their song choice pre approved by the organisers.
8. Contestants may be accompanied in any of the following ways:
  - (a) by playing their own instrument
  - (b) be backed by no more than one musician
  - (c) by using pre-recorded backing tracks (e.g. karaoke CD's). *The backing tracks need to be supplied to the organisers 1 week prior to the heat.*It is not permissible to sing along with a standard audio track.
9. Finalists must be available to perform in Lane Cove Plaza on Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> September between 1.00- 2.30pm. In the event of rain the final will be held at Synergy Youth Centre.
10. Organisers take no responsibility for lost, stolen or damaged equipment.
11. Contestants indemnify Lane Cove Council and its agents from any actions, claims or demands of any kind resulting from personal injury, property loss or actions of contestants.
